May, 2018 Financial Report

Weekly Collections for May totaled - \$19,064.11, or an average \$4,766.02/week.

Our budget for the same period is \$22,640 which means we were \$3,575.89 **under budget** for the month. Weekly Collections for the fiscal year ending in April are \$246,730.16. Our budget for weekly collections is \$271,680. We thank everyone for their generous support.

Gift Card sales for the month totaled \$9,685 showing a profit of \$457.00. Total sales so far for this fiscal year are \$155,795 for a profit of \$6,841.86. Last year's total for the same timeframe were: sales of \$144,035 for a profit of \$5,992.04.

Please remember that gift cards are available weekly for any type of purchases from a large selection of stores. Purchasing gift cards through the SCRIP Program is a great way to help support the church. A percentage of each card sold goes directly to Most Holy Trinity.


