**October, 2018 Bulletin Report**

Weekly Collections for October totaled - \$40,122.81, of which \$11,000 were a once a year donation. So, weekly collections after the \$11,000 were \$29,122.81.

- Our budget for the same period is \$28,400 which means we were \$722.80 over **budget** for the month. Currently, the total weekly collections for this fiscal year are \$105,500.64. Our 2018/2019 fiscal year's weekly collection goal is \$301,000. We do thank everyone for their generous support. Gift Card sales for the month totaled \$14,285.00 showing a profit of \$588.61. Last year's total for the same timeframe were: sales of \$13,685.00 for a profit of \$552.81.


