FAITH FORMATION NEWS

Faith Formation classes for grades 1-11 will begin on **September 13** after the 9:00 AM Mass. Anita Roseborough will be assisting our DRE, Rita Martinez this year. Please have your child wait at the inside entrance to the Education Center near the office. This is where your child should go each Sunday. A nurse will be there to take each child's temperature. Your child will then go into the Education Center and be directed to his/her classroom. Grades 1,2,3,7,9 will be on the first floor of the Education Center. Grades 4,5,6,8,10,11 will be on the second floor. We ask that you have your child wear a mask. We have arranged classrooms so that children are safely distanced from one another. Because there is just one Sunday Mass, we are going to extend the time for religious education. Instructional time will be from **10:10-11-45 a.m.** each Sunday. There will be a built-in snack time/stretch time with water and a snack. Our dismissal times will be staggered due to safe distancing. Grades 1-3 will be dismissed at 11:35 a.m. Please wait for your child on the sidewalk on 6th street. Grades 4-7 will dismiss at 11:40 a.m., grades 8-11 at 11:45 a.m. Again, parents should wait on the sidewalk on 6th street. We are uncertain as to the length of time that we will be able to meet in person, but we are reviewing programs for online learning if that becomes necessary. Please check the Facebook Most Holy Trinity Faith Formation page and the email address you provided the Church Office for cancellation of class due to weather, or other emergent critical information. We're looking forward to a wonderful year of learning and sharing our faith together.
